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#### 1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1. The Department has 2 x Firewalls (Cyber-room 300 and were upgraded to XG) installed and now has reached its EOL (End of Life) at HO. The firewall at HO needs to be in high availability two firewalls (2). There are five (5) District Offices without firewalls, which put LDPWRI Administration at risk of unauthorized access (e.g., hacking, denial of service, etc.).
- 1.2. The Department has decided to invest in seven (7) next generation Firewalls to mitigate the above-mentioned risks, two (2) X high end next generation Firewalls for Head Office site and 1 (one) medium end next generation Firewall for each 5 District Offices.
- 1.3. The seven (7) X next generation Firewalls will be supplied, installed, configured, and utilized at the following sites for 900 users: -
  - Head Office 43 Church Street, Polokwane (main server room/ data centre);
  - ❖ Capricorn District 29 Landros mare Street, Ext 46 Polokwane 0699. GPS Coordinates -23,93516;
  - Vhembe District Office, Erf 335 Thohoyandou-Q, Ext 3 with GPS Coordinates -22,82479;
  - Mopani District Office, District Government Offices, Giyani-A Giyani 0826;
  - Sekhukhune District Office, Erf 0 Lebowakgomo;
  - Waterberg District Office, Modimolle, Elias Motswaledi Street.
- 1.4. This document provides guidance and instructions for the service provider to be appointed to supply, install, and configure two (2) X high end next generation Firewall for Head Office site and five (5) x medium end next generation District Offices with 36 months licenses included.

#### 2. SCOPE OF WORK

- 2.1. The Department seeks to appoint a service provider to supply, install, and configure two (2) X next generation Firewall for Head Office site and five (5) District Offices including a once-off 900 licenses.
